# The New Queensland Government Privacy and FOI laws: the practical implications

New Privacy and Freedom of Information legislation affecting Queensland Government agencies has been passed and is taking effect from 1 July. The new FOI legislation differs in some important respects from the State's previous FOI laws and the privacy legislation is the first statutory privacy regime of its kind applicable to Queensland Government.

In this seminar, we will:

- examine how the new FOI legislation will operate and some of the key differences from Queensland's previous FOI regime
- explain some of the key implications of the new privacy legislation, the breadth of its application and the consequences for breach
- consider the processes for appeal and resolution of disputes arising from the operation of the new laws
